## Historical Sketch:

In 1984, citrus canker was found in the state of Florida. The Florida Canker Project, a multi-agency collaboration, was formed in response to this outbreak in 1985. It was co-led by the Florida Department of Agriculture and the United States Department of Agriculture who worked cooperatively with other government agencies, including the Florida Department of Citrus, in order to contain and eradicate this outbreak. Another, more widespread outbreak started in 1986, but it would later be declared exterminated in 1994.
