

# 2023 – 2024 All-Sports Handbook

#### **All-Sports Points Series**

The Intramural All-Sports Champion Point Series is for both men and women's teams that wish to compete all year long across a majority of sports. Teams will accumulate points based on participation, regular season, and playoff results. Independent teams can register for the All-Sports race. Greek organizations will be placed into the competition as well. The men's and women's winners of the All-Sports Award will be recognized at the end of year by the intramural department. In addition, each team will receive t-shirts and banner located in the Wellness Center Gym.

#### **Team Regulations**

## Independent Teams

Independent teams are those who are playing with no Greek affiliation. Independent teams may have Greek players on their team, but the points accrued count towards their respective Greek organization's points race. In order for independent teams to be eligible, they must participate in the majority of events offered throughout the year. They must also keep the same team name across all events, as this is how the intramural staff will track their points. Members of independent teams who participate in individual/dual events will be able to indicate which All-Sports team they are representing at the event check-in.

#### Greek Teams

Greek teams are those representing the fraternities and sororities recognized by FSC Office of Greek Life. Greek teams may have independent players participate on their team, but over the course of the year, 75% of their intramural roster must be in that organization. For example, if the organization had 100 total participants over the course of the year, at least 75 of them must be in the organization in order to qualify for All-Sports points. Greek teams must participate in the majority of events offered throughout the year. They must also use their Greek organization's name as their team name, as that is how the intramural staff will track their points. Members of Greek teams who participate in individual/dual events will be able to indicate which All-Sports team they are representing at the event check-in.

#### Number of Teams Allowed

If an organization wants to enter multiple teams into the same league/division, they have that option. In Team League Sports, they may enter two teams into to be eligible towards All-Sports Points competition, but the teams must reflect the organization name. They will receive points for the team who advances the farthest.

In One-Day Event/Team Tournaments, as well as Individual and Dual Tournaments or events, there is no limit on the number of teams entered, and they will receive the points for the team that advances the farthest.

For NIRSA Day, teams will only receive points for a certain number of teams/participants for each event. This number will be announced at a date closer to NIRSA Day.

# Point Distribution

#### Participation

Teams are eligible receive the following points at the completion of the season/event. Teams can only receive these points as long as they did not forfeit any games during the season/event and must have maintained an average sportsmanship rating of "2.0" or above.

Category	Points
Team Event/League Sport	200
One-Day/Weekend Team Tournament	100*
Individual/Doubles Tournament/Special Event	25 per person/pair, up to 100*

\* The team will receive one point for each additional person/pair participating under the team's name over the 100 point maximum for each event. For example, if ten people from a team submit a March Madness bracket, they

will receive 106 total participation points, 100 for the initial four participants, and one point for each of the remaining.

#### Performance

Teams will receive the following points based on their performance:

#### **Deductions**

If a team has a forfeit during any point of the sport, they will not receive any of the allotted participation points for that event unless otherwise cleared by the intramural office.

Poor Sportsmanship Ratings will also be grounds for deductions.

- If a player gets ejected the team will lose ½ of their participation points for that sport.
- If a team receives a "1.0" during either the regular season or playoffs, they will automatically lose ½ of their participation points for that sport.
- If a team receives a "0" during either the regular season or playoffs they will automatically lose all of their participation points for that sport.

\*Reservation Clause: The intramural office reserves the right to adjust and amend points as deemed necessary by the Assistant Director of Wellness – Intramural Sports & Facilities and the Intramural Staff. The intramural office also reserves the right to penalize teams additional points for excessive unsporting behavior in multiple sports.

#### Sportsmanship Points – New Fall 2022

In league sports, the team from each division (Men's / Women's) with the best overall Sportsmanship Rating will receive +50 All-Sports Points. In the case that there is more than one team with the top Sportsmanship Rating (i.e.; a tie), the points will be split amongst the teams.

#### CoRec Points – New Fall 2021

In league sports, organizations have the opportunity to earn +50 All-Sports Points. To earn these points, both organizations must have their name listed in the team name and follow all other participation requirements (No forfeits, meeting minimum Sportsmanship Rating, etc.) to earn the +50 Points.

A maximum of +50 can be earned per organization per league sport.

## COVID-19

The Intramural Sports program is committed to providing safe programming throughout the COVID-19 pandemic. This manual will be updated as policies and procedures for participants and staff alike are changed to provide the safest atmosphere possible for all parties involved. Sports and tournaments may be rescheduled or cancelled based on COVID procedures and protocols that are constantly being developed within the college. The Intramural Staff will keep participants informed on these decisions.

## Swim Meet Update – Fall 2023

In an attempt to make the Intramural Swim meet more even and fair in the All-Sports Race, points will be given out per race (both men's / women's and relay races).

- First Place: 3 Points
- Second Place: 2 Points
- Third Place: 1 Point

If a team has a swimmer finish in first and second place, they will only receive points for first place (3 Points).

At the end of the Swim Meet, points will be given out based on final placement.

- First Place: 30 Points
  - Second place: 15 Points
  - o Third Place: 8 Points
  - Fourth Place: 4 Points

#### 9/11 Stair Climb Challenge

All-Sports teams can earn points by completing the 9/11 Stair Climb Challenge. Each participant that completes the challenge will be awarded +5 ASP for their organization. A maximum of 20 participants can complete the challenge for a maximum of +100 points. The challenge must be completed before the deadline and it must be recorded properly on the sign-in sheet in the HWC.

One person is welcome to complete the challenge more than once, but they will receive only +5 points regardless of the number of times they complete it.

#### **Moc Games Participation**

Organizations / ASP teams that provide team(s) to participate in Moc Games will receive +25 ASP. If a team is split (Kappa Delta / Alpha Chi Omega, Theta Chi / Kappa Delta, etc.) the points will be split and each team will receive 12.5 ASP.

In order to receive points for Moc Games, teams must provide enough people to play and must not be late.
