

WHAT to BRING and WHEN to BRING IT!

You should report to the **music building** for registration between **1:00pm and 3:00pm on Sunday, June 24th. Remember to eat lunch before you arrive. During Registration you will sign-up for your elective, get your audition time, receive your meal card and dorm assignments. (NO room changes will be made during this time).** You will also be given a detailed schedule that will include a daily schedule and evening activities.

AUDITIONS: will be held at the Music Building from **1:30pm – 4:00 pm**. There is a lot to do so please be on time. Bring your instrument! Be prepared to play a short etude (music selection) from a band book, solo or ALL STATE exercise and scales.

PERCUSSION Be prepared to audition on Snare & Mallets! Must provide own sticks and mallets. (Basic Set includes, Snare Sticks, Bell Mallets, Xylophone Mallets, Tympani Mallets)

RESIDENT CAMPER - Your tuition includes all instruction, dinner on Sunday, three meals a day Monday - Friday and breakfast on Saturday, June 26th.

DAY CAMPER – Must attend Sunday evening Orientation and Rehearsal. Your tuition includes all instruction and lunch, Monday – Friday. Day Campers that are staying for the evening may purchase dinner at the school cafeteria.

HEALTH FORM – NOTARIZED! There will be a \$5.00 fee for any forms needing to be notarized during registration. Please bring the enclosed health form with you, signed by your parent or guardian. A doctor's signature is not required.

Also needed is a copy of your insurance card - front/back. Please send in ahead of time to speed up the registration process.

PARENTAL PERMISSION - Campers are **NOT** allowed to leave the camp at any time. Students who provide their own transportation to the camp must turn in car keys to dorm parents at time of registration.
