Terms of Agreement:

- ◆ I understand that if I fail to check into housing by the second day of classes, my housing assignment will be cancelled, but that I will still be responsible for the fees associated with my room.
- ◆ **I understand that I am assured housing for the times classes are in session.** Only students with special permission will be allowed to remain over the break periods and additional charges may be assessed.
- ◆ I understand that I must purchase a meal plan as a residential student.
- ◆ I understand that I am responsible for knowing and abiding by all college policies and directives of the Office of Community Living. The Student Handbook can be viewed at www.flsouthern.edu on the Student Life page.
- ◆ I understand any damage to personal property is not the responsibility of the college. This applies no matter the cause for the damage or loss. Resident students are encouraged to obtain their own insurance coverage.
- ◆ I understand that college personnel will need to gain access to my room/apartment for various reasons during the academic year. The reasons include, but are not limited to, making repairs, health and fire safety inspections, safety inspections during break periods, or for violations of policy as outlined in the student handbook. Whenever possible, advance notice of entry will be given, but is not required.
- ◆ I understand the Office of Community Living reserves the right to consolidate students left in a double or triple room without a roommate. Prior to this consolidation, students will be offered the option of selecting a roommate or reserving the room as a private space for a prorated amount if space is available.
- ◆ I understand that I must maintain full-time student status at Florida Southern College in order to live in the residence halls or campus-owned apartments. (12 credits for undergraduates and 9 hours for graduate students)
- ◆ I understand that the Office of Community Living reserves the right to assign roommates and change room assignments. The Office of Community Living will make every effort to assign roommates based on similar life-style characteristics.
- ◆ **Residential students who wish to apply for commuter status or want to cancel housing must do so in writing no later than June 1 for the Fall semester or December 14 for the Spring semester. A \$500.00 charge will be posted to the student's account if the Office of Community Living is not notified by these dates.** Students may cancel their housing agreement by notifying, in writing, the Office of Community Living. Students wishing to change to commuter status must apply to be considered for an exemption from the residency requirement in the Office of Student Life (specific qualifications must be met to obtain commuter status). Current full-time enrolled residents, leaving the residence halls or apartments during the academic year without a release from the agreement, continue to be responsible for the room charges that accrue against their accounts.
