All Sport Points Series 2009-2010:

The Intramural All-Sports Point System for both men and women teams that wish to compete all year long. Teams wishing to compete for the All-Sports Award must participate in all team sports offered by the Intramural program. Teams will accumulate points based on participation, regular season and playoff results.

Independent All Sport teams must consist of at least 8 “core” players. Core players must compete in all those sports with a regular season and playoffs. For those events requiring less than 8 players, all participants must be core players. For Greek All-Sports teams, there are no “core” players. A team may only have all active Greek members, in order to get points for their organization in one-day tournaments. For regular season events, at any point in time, any Greek team must be comprised of no less than 75% of that organization’s active members. For instance, if a basketball team has 12 players, at least 9 of them must be active members of that fraternity or sorority. Only one team per sport can acquire All-Sports Points.

That will then be the team that accumulates points for that organization. Once a core player commits to a team he/she must continue to play for that team the entire school year. All other participants may switch teams as described in the Roster section of the manager’s packet.

The men’s and women’s winners of the All Sports Award will be recognized at the end of year banquet sponsored by the Wellness Center. In addition, their team name will be added to the All Sports Award plaque located in the Nina B. Hollis Wellness Center Lobby and banner located in the Wellness Center Gym.

Three categories of events:

I: Team Events: (league sports)

II: One-day Team Events

III: Individual Events

I: Team Events: (league sports) (A team will earn 150 participation points for league sports)

To earn the “participation points” the team cannot have any forfeits, or a sportsmanship rating less than 2.

FALL: Flag Football, Indoor Volleyball & Softball

SPRING: Basketball, Soccer & Ultimate Frisbee

II: One-day/weekend Team Events: (A team will earn 100 participation points for a one day/weekend tournament)

FALL: Wiffleball Tourney & Bowling Tourney

SPRING: 4 on 4 Flag Tourney & Dodgeball Tourney

III: Individual/Doubles One Day/league Events: (25 participation points per person/pair, 100 points max)

FALL: Billiards, Table Tennis & Tailgate Triathlon

SPRING: Tennis, 5K Walk, Swim Meet, & Golf Tourney

IV: Deductions:

Forfeit:

(Team sport) 1st (- half participation points), 2nd (lose all sport participation points)

(One day/weekend Team event) Any forfeits during a one day/weekend Team event will result in loss of all sport participation points.

(Individual/Doubles) Any forfeits during an individual/double on day/league event will result in loss of all sport participation points.

Sportsmanship Rating:

(Team sport/one day/weekend tournaments)

- If a player gets ejected the team will lose ½ of their participation points.
- If a team receives a “1” during either the regular season or playoffs they will automatically lose ½ of their participation points.
- If a team receives a “0” during either the regular season or playoffs they will automatically lose all of their participation points.

V. Placing points

Team Event Placing Points

Team Participation points: 150 points

Regular season games: Win = 3 points, Loss = 0 points, Tie = 1 point

Playoff games: Win = 3 points, Loss = 0 points, Tie = 1 point

Playoff Championship Placing points: 1st place = 40 points, 2nd place = 30 points, 3rd/4th place = 20 points

One-day/weekend team event

Participation points: 100 points

Bracket Play:(Each win during bracket play = 3 points, Each loss during bracket play = 0 points)

Championship Placing points: 1st place = 20 points, 2nd place = 15 points, 3rd/4th place = 10 points

Individual/Doubles One day Event

Participation points: 25 pts per person/pair(100 pts Max)

***Game/Bracket play:(Each win during bracket play = 3 points, Each loss during bracket play = 0 points)

Championship Placing points: 1st place = 20 points, 2nd place = 15 points, 3rd/4th place = 10 points

***This does not include 5k Walk, Swim meet & Golf Tourney
