FILM (B.F.A.) PORFOLIO REQUIRMENTS

In order to receive an art-based scholarship at Florida Southern College, you must submit a portfolio for review. You may submit your portfolio digitally or meet with a professor for an in-person portfolio review. Please do not send physical video/film to the department.

We prefer that you upload the video files of your best work to a folder on **Google Drive or Dropbox** and email the link to Professor **Matthew Herbertz (mherbertz@flsouthern.edu)** and **Ria Outlaw (moutlaw@flsouthern.edu)** You should select your best works to submit. Quality over quantity!

Submission Requirements:

1. PERSONAL STATEMENT (500 words MAX)

The BFA in film at Florida Southern aims to cultivate the next generation of responsible and unique storytellers.

With this in mind, choose one of the following prompts:

- Briefly describe how you will contribute to the culture of storytelling at Florida Southern.
- How will pursuing a BFA in Film at FSC help to fulfill your career aspirations?

2. PORTFOLIO:

Please submit **at least ONE** of the following:

Video/Film Work (15 min. TOTAL runtime)

Creative Written Work: screenplay or short story/etc. (25 pages max)

Other Visual Work (paintings/drawings/photography/etc.)

****NOTE:** You may submit a combination of work from the above categories, but please only submit your BEST for each category.

Work should be submitted via a SINGLE Dropbox or Google Drive link. Remember to submit your best work!
