

## SAMPLE ADULT UNDERGRADUATE TUITION BREAKDOWN

To graduate from Florida Southern College, students must complete a minimum of 124 credit hours. Below is a table of sample tuition breakdowns based on the number of credit hours an adult student transfers into FSC.

Adult Undergraduate Tuition Breakdown, 2020\*

Transferable Credits*	Remaining Credits**	EASE Grant***	Total Tuition****
0 credits	124	\$8,400	\$32,520
30 credits	94	\$5,600	\$25,420
60 credits	64	\$4,200	\$16,920

**2020\*** - Tuition breakdown in the above table is based on the 2020-2021 academic year cost per credit hour rate, which is \$330.

**Transferable Credits\*\*** - Transferable credits are determined by the Registrar's Office upon acceptance. Credits that will be considered transferable are ones from regionally-accredited institutions, where grades of 'C' or better are earned.

**Remaining Credits\*\*** - Students may need to complete more than a total of 124 credit hours to meet degree requirements.

**EASE Grant\*\*\*** - Students eligible for the EASE grant are Florida residents who are enrolled full time in the fall and spring semesters. The EASE grant is not applicable during the summer. The EASE grant calculation is determined by the number of years a student is enrolled at Florida Southern, which is based on a student completing 36 credit hours per academic year.

**Total Tuition\*\*\*\*** - This total tuition amount is a rough estimate. These totals do not include additional financial aid such as the Pell grant and federal and private loans. Pell grants and loans are determined by the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) based on student financial need.
