


OF COURSE, THERE'S ALSO PLENTY OF CAREER PREPARATION

Earning a bachelor's degree shouldn't take more than eight semesters. That's why we guarantee first-year students the ability to graduate in four years.


OUR FOUR-YEAR PROMISE


