# Tail-Wagging or Rule-Breaking? Understanding FSC's Pet Policy

While students are preparing to return to campus, the Offices of Community Living and Student Conduct would like to share a timely reminder regarding FSC's Pet Policy.

No pets are permitted in any residential facility, including apartments and houses. Small fish are allowed in aquariums of 10 gallons or less. Any animal that has not been approved as an Emotional Support Animal or Service Animal is considered a pet. Because pets are prohibited in all residential facilities, a violation fine will be assessed to the animal owner/host. The owner/host will have 24 hours to humanely remove the animal from campus. Students seeking approval for a Service Animal or Emotional Support Animal must contact the Office of Student Disability Services to initiate the review process.
