Convenient Schedule

We understand that adult learners have obligations outside of school. That is why we have flexible and convenient course schedules that can be customized to your specific needs. Courses are offered on campus in the evenings or fully online. Students can create a hybrid schedule by taking some courses on campus and some online or opt to complete the bachelor's degree fully online. FSC's adult accounting program offers different delivery formats to provide options based on each student's needs.

Program Overview

Florida Southern offers a comprehensive accounting major that prepares students for professional certification. Students learn accounting applications from accomplished faculty who are committed to teaching and professional excellence.

Professional Certification

After completing the Bachelor of Science in Accounting, you are eligible to take the Certified Managerial Accounting (CMA) exam. You will also have completed the prerequisite courses required to continue into Florida Southern's Master of Accountancy (MAcc) program, which satisfies the semester hours requirement to sit for the Certified Public Accounting (CPA) exam.

Engaged Learning

With dedicated faculty members and small class sizes, you will enjoy engaging lessons through open discussions with peers, utilizing our virtual learning platform or participating in synchronous online courses.

Personalized Attention

The moment you enroll, you will be assigned an Academic Advisor to see you through your experience from start to finish. Your advisor will help you develop a customized educational plan that fits your schedule and priorities.

Accelerated Program

Adult undergraduate programs are offered in flexible, 7-week terms that begin six times a year, allowing you to start your degree at your convenience. You can complete your degree at a pace that fits your lifestyle and take up to 12 classes per year (48 credit hours). Upper-level accounting courses are completed in a semester-long time frame, benefiting students' overall success in preparing them to sit for the CPA exam.

Executive Learning Environment

Our state-of-the-art Becker Business Building is where we offer undergraduate and graduate courses on campus. This learning center is available to adult students and is where our hybrid courses are taught. It offers a simulation trading floor and a market research lab. It is also where you will find faculty offices. Additionally, we have student break out rooms providing a place for adult students to come and study in a quiet, non-distracting environment.

Accounting Major Requirements

Students who have earned an Associate of Arts (A.A.) degree from a regionally accredited community college in Florida will have met all General Education requirements and may earn up to 62 credit hours toward their degree.

For students who have earned an Associate of Science (A.S.) degree, a maximum of 62 credit hours from a regionally accredited community college may be applied to the degree.

If an A.A. was not earned at another institution prior to matriculation at Florida Southern, general education requirements are awarded on a course-by-course equivalency.

Financial Aid

Tuition deferment is available to students receiving employer reimbursement. FSC participates in all major Federal Aid programs including military funding, as well as State of Florida programs such as the Florida Resident Access Grant and Bright Futures.

Admission Requirements

- Completed online application
- Provide official transcripts of all academic work taken previously at other colleges, universities, or professional schools.
- If fewer than 25 credit hours have been earned from a regionally accredited college or university, student should provide official high school transcript or GED scores, as well as ACT or SAT exam scores, OR as an alternative, applicants should instead submit an updated resume and elect to apply through the test-optional policy.
- Military service-connected, educational experiences may award transfer credits. Requests should be accompanied by documents describing the educational experience. (Seven semester hours of credit may be awarded.)
