## WHAT WILL I STUDY?

Technical management requires a diverse set of skills. The **B.F.A. in Technical Theatre/Design** sequence of courses focuses first on developing creative expression through acting, improvisation, and script analysis. To assure comprehensive training, once you've built a foundation, you may choose to pursue elective courses that lead to a concentration in scenic, lighting, sound, or costume design, or stage management.
