Historical Sketch:

The Athletic Education Training Program (ATEP) was a Bachelor's degree program offered at Florida Southern College from 1999 to 2019. Exploration of creating the program first began in 1997; by 1998, ATEP had hired its first director. Classes began in the fall of 1999, and ATEP filed its initial candidacy application for accreditation in the same year. The program was fully accredited in October 2001 by the Joint Review Committee on Educational Programs in Athletic Training (JRC-AT) under the Commission on Accreditation of Allied Health Educational Programs (CAAHEP), now known as the Commission on Accreditation of Athletic Training Education (**CAATE**).

In 2002, Sue Stanley-Green was appointed Athletic Education Training Program Director, a position she would hold until her retirement in 2019. In 2004, Dr. James "Mick" Lynch was hired as the program's Clinical Education Coordinator. When the program began, ATEP was under the Social Sciences Division under the Physical Education department. After a college-wide realignment of divisions and departments, ATEP became part of the Nursing and Health Sciences Division by the 2007-2008 academic year. Under both divisions, ATEP worked alongside the Physical Education department and the Human Movement and Performance department, which later became Exercise Science. ATEP also worked closely with the College's Athletics Department by providing athletic training services for student-athletes as well as a clinical location for ATEP students.

In May 2015, CAATE **decided** that a Master's degree in Athletic Training would be the mandatory professional degree for accredited athletic trainers; therefore, all accreditation of Bachelor's degree programs would cease in the fall of 2022. In accordance, in May 2016, FSC ATEP submitted its withdrawal from CAATE accreditation effective May 2020 in order to allow the last cohort to graduate in May 2019. As planned, the program ceased in May 2020.

During the program's duration, ATEP also established the Xi chapter of Iota Tau Alpha, a national honor society for athletic trainers. The chapter was founded at FSC in 2006, and it presumably dissolved in 2019 with the last cohort of graduates. The Sports Medicine Society was another student group created by ATEP and also ended with the last cohort.

Scope and Content note:

The FSC Athletic Training Education Program Records covers the academic and administrative materials both created and used by the Athletic Training Education Program at Florida Southern College. The collection has been arranged into series alphabetically by topic:

The **Accreditation** series included two subseries, the first is the *Commission on Accreditation of Athletic Training Education (CAATE)* which contains documentation from the accreditation process that ATEP underwent to be certified by CAATE. Included are self-study reports as well as follow-ups, annual reports, and correspondence regarding accreditation. *Southern Association of Colleges and Schools (SACS)* sub-series contains the information sent to SACS regarding the termination of the Athletic Training Education Program

The **Budget** series contains departmental budget information for ATEP, including yearly budget reports.

The **Board of Certification (BoC)** series contains information concerning the certification of ATEP students in order to become licensed athletic trainers. Included are anonymous

aggregate exam results, mock examinations, and test preparation materials as well as information concerning ATEP being a certified Continuing Education Credit provider for the credits needed for certification and recertification.

The **Clinicals** series includes three subseries about assignments, instructors and sites. The *Clinical Assignments* sub-series contains lists of where ATEP students were assigned to in order to fulfill the clinical requirement of the degree program. The *Clinical Instructors* sub-series contains information on the clinical instructors, including ATEP applications, résumés (confidential), certifications, and licenses. The *Clinical Sites* sub-series contains information on the sites ATEP students worked at as part of their clinical experience. Included are site agreements, credentials, and rules and regulations.

The **Conferences and Workshops** series contains materials from conferences attended as well as hosted by ATEP personnel. Conferences are defined as events that typically occurred over multiple days that had multiple foci with a typical lecture-based approach. Workshops are defined as events that typically occurred during a single day that had a singular, narrow focus with a typical hands-on approach. This sub-series contains materials from workshops attended as well as hosted by ATEP personnel.

Correspondence contains general correspondence to and from ATEP personnel. The file description uses the topic of the correspondence.

Courses is divided into two series Classes and Course Materials. *Classes* includes information from some of classes taught in ATEP. In this sub-series are syllabi, specified course reference materials, and exams for each course folder. Also included in this sub-series are the Junior Journeys (study abroad classes) hosted by ATEP faculty. *Course Materials* contain course references materials for ATEP. These are materials believed to have been used as part of ATEP courses, but have no specific course identifier. Materials include readings, handouts, mock exams, and a textbook.

The **Curriculum** series includes curriculum proposals, competency and proficiency reports, internal assessment reports, and documentation on any program level changes or discussions.

Events and Programming contain information and documents of events hosted by ATEP or ones that ATEP personnel attended. Events include lectures, banquets, field trips, and legislative advocacy events.

The **Meetings** series contains information regarding ATEP internal meetings and external department-wide meetings in Athletics as well as the Nursing and Health Sciences division.

The **Organizations** series includes information on the three FSC organizations affiliated with ATEP: Iota Tau Alpha honor society, Best Buddies, and the Sports Medicine Society.

The **Personnel** series is subdivided into four subseries. *Awards* contain the awards presented to ATEP students by the department. Two of the awards are named for Physical Education department staff (Katherine Straw and Kathy Benn) and one is named in memory of a student who passed away in 2001 (Phillip Cooper). *Lists* contains lists of student cohort and alumni. The *Photographs* contains analog photographs of ATEP personnel and events. The *Press* sub-series contains newspaper and magazine articles on ATEP students and faculty.

The **Policies and Procedures** series includes blank *Forms* used by the department and policies and procedures *Manuals* for ATEP and the Athletics Department.

Storage Media includes storage media from various aspects of ATEP. The CD-ROMs contain materials such as photographs, course materials, and forms. The Hard Drive contains backup files from ATEP as well as the affiliated departments of Physical Education, Human Movement and Performance, Exercise Science, and Sports Management. Included are course syllabi and other materials, forms, and personnel lists.

Notes to Researchers:

- ATEP was involved with the following national and regional athletic training organizations:
 - The Commission on Accreditation of Athletic Training Education (**CAATE**) is the accrediting organization for athletic training degree programs. Until June 30 2006, the organization was known as the Joint Review Committee on Educational Programs in Athletic Training (**JRC-AT**) under the Commission on Accreditation of Allied Health Educational Programs (**CAAHEP**).
 - The National Athletic Trainers' Association (**NATA**) is professional membership organization for athletic trainers. It currently does not provide certification or accreditation. ATEP was also part of District IX of Southeast Athletic Trainers' Association (**SEATA**), a regional division of NATA.
 - The Board of Certification (**BoC**) is the certifying organization for athletic trainers. It is currently independent of CAATE and NATA, though all three companies are affiliates. However, BoC was formerly known as **NATABoC** and was part of NATA until 2003.

- The Athletic Trainers' Association of Florida (**ATAF**) is an independent, statewide professional organization for athletic trainers.
- For the **Courses** series, from the start of ATEP in 1999 to the end of 2009-2010 academic year, course codes were the departmental prefix following by a three-digit course number (i.e. ATP301). From the 2010-2011 academic year on, the course code is the departmental prefix followed by a four-digit course number (i.e. ATP3333).
