

TCI Program Frequently Asked Questions

1. Can this program be completed 100% online?
 - a. This program is 100% online incorporating engaged learning and transformational concepts for students from the convenience of a virtual classroom.
2. Is financial aid available?
 - a. Students seeking financial aid should complete the FAFSA to determine eligibility.
3. What is the cost of textbooks?
 - a. The cost of textbooks varies each semester and by course.
4. How many classes is considered full time?
 - a. A student is considered full time when taking a minimum of 8 credit hours at the graduate level.
5. Will I receive supplemental pay with this degree?
 - a. Most school districts offer supplemental pay upon completion of this degree. You are encouraged to contact your school district for more information regarding supplemental pay.
6. How can this degree help my career?
 - a. This degree will strengthen your skills as a classroom teacher as well as provide you with more options regarding your career path in other district level positions, higher level education teaching positions and the opportunity in a doctoral level degree program.
7. How long does it typically take to complete the program?
 - a. Most students complete the program in as few as four semesters.
8. How will I know which classes to take each semester?
 - a. Your academic advisor will create a schedule for you to follow from beginning to end of the program. Your academic advisor will assist you in registering for courses each semester and will ensure you are completing all requirements throughout the program.
