Theatre Audition Requirements:

For the BFA Musical Theatre audition, students should prepare two contrasting pieces:

- One song should be a ballad and one song should be an uptempo.
- One song should be written before 1970.
- One song should be written after 1970.
- Each song should be 60-90 seconds.
- Please have accompaniment tracks. A wireless speaker will be provided.
- Please bring a headshot, resume, and two letters of recommendation.

For the BFA Performance audition, students should prepare two contrasting pieces:

- One dramatic monologue should be classical or contemporary.
- One comedic monologue should be classical or contemporary.
- At least one monologue must be contemporary (written after 1970).
- Monologues must be from a published play or monologue collection. Monologues cannot be from musicals, television shows, or movies.
- Please bring a headshot, resume, and two letters of recommendation.

For the BFA Technical Theatre interview, students should prepare the following:

- An artistic resume that highlights your artistic work or applicable experiences.
- A digital portfolio that shows the process and results of your artistic work or applicable experiences.
- Two letters of recommendation from people you have worked with as an artist (i.e., director, designer, teacher, or supervisor).

Dance Audition Requirements:

If you are auditioning for the BFA Dance Performance and Choreography or BA Dance Studies degree programs and would like to be considered for a talent-based scholarship, you must submit a streaming link (YouTube, Vimeo, Google Drive, etc.) of a solo performance in any dance style of your choice to danceauditions@flsouthern.edu. This recording may be from a previous formal performance or informal in a dance studio. Individual files that need to be downloaded will not be accepted.
