Florida Southern College students who are currently enrolled in the Bachelor of Science in Accounting may begin their MAcc program in the fall of their senior year. Students are eligible to complete the MAcc program in conjunction with their bachelor's degree.

Early Admission (Early MAcc)

1. General requirements for admission into the program have been met (See the catalog on General Admission Requirements)
2. GPA of 3.0 overall (cumulative) at FSC
3. GPA of 3.0 in accounting (ACC) courses
4. Application deadline for early admission is May 1 of the junior year, and admission is contingent upon the GPA on June 1 of that year.
5. MAcc Director Approval

Program Costs

Fall Semester Start—The published traditional undergraduate, full-time tuition will be assessed for enrollment in the first two regular semesters for students enrolled in the early MAcc program. The remaining semesters in the program will be charged at the prevailing MAcc program graduate per credit rate.

Financial Aid

Fall Semester Start—Undergraduate financial aid is available during enrollment. For more information on the Early MAcc program contact the Financial Aid Office at 863.680.4140.

Academic Advisor

From the moment you enroll, the MAcc Director will be assigned as your Academic Advisor to see you through your experience from start to finish. Your advisor will help you develop an educational plan that matches your schedule and priorities.

Professional Certification Prep

The MAcc program provides everything you need to sit for the Uniform CPA Examination in Florida and most other states. Additionally, a CPA Exam Review can be taken as a part of the elective courses in the Early MAcc program.

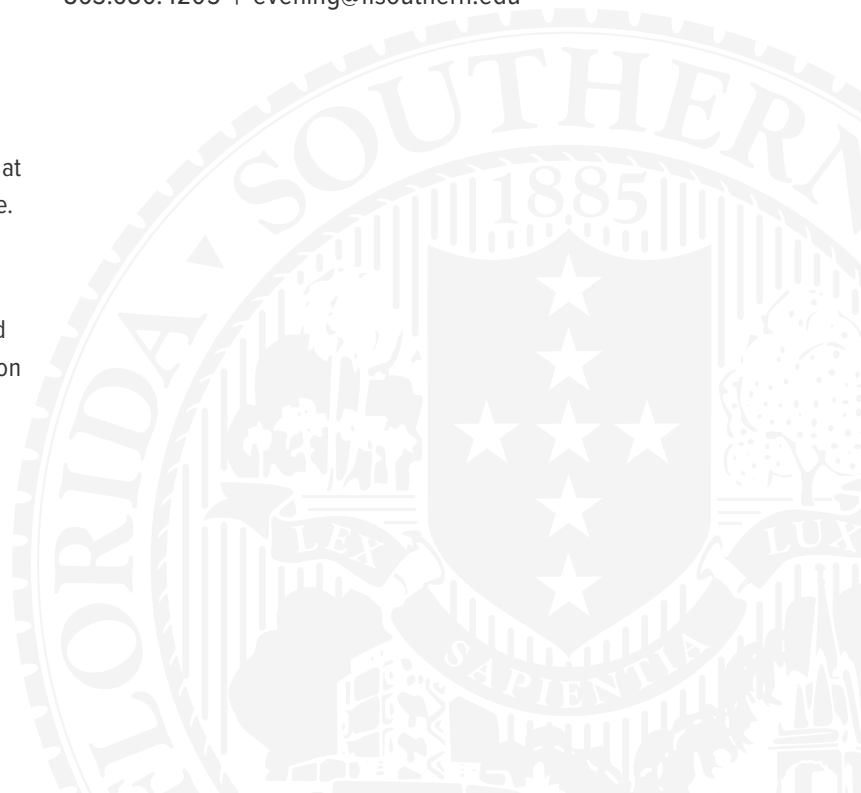
