Question stems that lend themselves to the "Evidence" category typically seek specific examples, historical or factual information, or concrete data to support or illustrate a topic.

Question stems for the "Analysis/Understanding" category are typically designed to prompt deeper thinking, critical evaluation, and a more comprehensive understanding of a topic.
