Biographical Sketch:

Dr. James R. Iley was born in 1930 in Plant City, Florida. After graduating high school, Iley worked in the agricultural industry for a few years until he started at Florida Southern College in 1950. He graduated in 1954 with a Bachelor of Science in Chemistry. In 1960, he began attending the University of Florida where he earned his PhD in 1963. By 1969, Dr. Iley had begun working at the Soil Science Foundation in Lakeland, Florida as the Associate Technical Director. In 1970, upon the death of Dr. O.C. Bryan, Dr. Iley became the Technical Director of Applied Agricultural Research, Inc. (formerly Soil Science Foundation). He held this position until the dissolution of the company around 1993. Dr. James R. Iley passed away in 2005.
