

2026-2027 Dress Code

At The Roberts Academy, we believe that a consistent and respectful dress code helps create a positive learning environment, fosters school pride, and encourages students to present themselves with confidence and professionalism. We appreciate your partnership in upholding these standards and ensuring that all students are dressed for success. Risse Brothers School Uniforms is the approved uniform supplier for the 2026-2027 school year.

Bottoms: Khaki or navy shorts, pants, or skorts with RA letters

Tops: Red or blue short-sleeved or long-sleeved shirts with The Roberts Academy logo

Other Dress Code Rules:

- Shoes must be safe and appropriate – no flip flops, slides, open-toe shoes, sandals, Crocs (closed-toe shoes preferred)
- Clothes must be the appropriate size, with the waist of the garment worn at the student's waist
- Shorts/skirts must be mid-thigh or longer
- A belt is required if the garment has belt loops
- Shirts must be tucked in
- Only Risse Brothers bottoms are permitted
- Shirts and jackets from the previous uniform supplier may still be worn (including green shirts in grades 6-8)
- School administrators have the final authority in determining whether a student's attire complies with the school's dress code policy. If a student arrives at school not in compliance with the dress code, the student will be asked to remedy the situation as soon as possible, and the student's family will be contacted. Depending on the nature of the violation, families may be required to bring appropriate clothing to school or take the student home to change before returning to class. Repeated dress code violations may result in progressive disciplinary action or other consequences deemed appropriate by the administration.

Jackets/Sweaters/Sweatshirts and Coats

- Students may wear only red jackets/sweatshirts with The Roberts Academy logo
- If coats or other outerwear are worn to/from school, students will remove them upon entering the classroom and keep them stored in the classroom throughout the school day

Additional Information

- Students' clothing, hair, and appearance may not be disruptive, distracting, or display offensive language/symbols, etc.
- Clothing must not have any colored trim, stripes, embroidery, decoration, etc.
- School buildings are climate controlled. Blankets, additional jackets, or outerwear are not allowed.
