

CLEP Testing Information

1. Permission & Eligibility

- **FSC Students:** Submit a [CLEP Permission Application](#) to the [Registrar's Office](#) (Registrar@flsouthern.edu).

2. Fees

- **CLEP Exam Fee:** \$95, (\$97 after July 1st) payable at CLEP Portal. Bring your **Exam Registration Ticket**.
- **FSC Testing Fee:** \$35, charged to your student account on test day (no cash/check required).
- **Military Personnel:** CLEP testing is free for eligible military personnel. For details, visit:
 - Military Testing
 - Veterans Reimbursement

3. ID Requirements

- Bring a **government-issued ID** with a photo and signature.

4. Preparation

- **Study Guide:** Available at the Roux Library.
- Visit <https://clep.collegeboard.org/prepare-for-an-exam> for free practice tests and study tips.
- **Retest Policy:** You must wait **3 months** before retaking the same exam.

- CLEP credits may count toward degree requirements but **do not affect your GPA**.
- A minimum GPA of **2.0** at FSC is required to take CLEP exams.
- **Credit by examination** will not be awarded for areas where comparable coursework has been attempted (including "W"ithdrawals).
- You may **not retake the same CLEP exam** within **3 months**.
