

# P3 SUGGESTED SEQUENCE

Below is for information purposes and represents the <u>suggeste</u>d sequence to complete the pre-professional program; alternative sequencing is possible.

Additional requirements necessary for completion, see the Pre-Professional Program Guidelines for full details.

## PART 1 — PREPARE TO APPLY TO P3

### First Year (Fall & Spring)

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Attend the Pre-Health 101 Workshop (available in Fall or Spring)
Take PHP 1997: Introduction to Health Professions (available Fall or Spring)
☐ Complete the online HIPPA Training
☐ Complete the online Global Ambassador Training
Participate in at least one of the following extracurricular activities: Alpha Epsilon Delta (strongly recommended) leadership experience, competitive internship or summer REU, intercollegiate athletics, or related employment.
If workload allows, begin obtaining professional observation hours and/or community service hours
Take required science courses and maintain required GPA
Have resume reviewed by the FSC Career Center or the Science and Pre-Health Career and Internship Coordinator
Second Year (Summer & Fall)
If you have not already, begin participating in professional observation and/or clinical exposure (you must complete a <u>minimum</u> of 50 hours by January 15th of second year)
If you have not already, begin participating in community service (you must complete a <u>minimum</u> of 20 hours by January 15 <sup>th</sup> of second year; cannot "double dip" with professional observation/clinical exposure)
Take required science courses and maintain required GPA
By January 15th of the Second (or Third) Year: Apply to P3

## Part 2 — Prepare to Complete P3

#### Second Year (Spring) & Third Year (Summer, Fall, Spring)

Attend the Crucial Year Workshop (available in Fall)
Attend the Interview Workshop (available in Fall and Spring)
Attend the Gap Year Workshop (available in Fall)
Complete a minimum of 100 hrs of professional observation and/or clinical exposure (since the start of first year)
Complete a minimum of 40 hrs of community service (since the start of first year; cannot "double dip" with professional observation)
Participate in a mock interview
Write personal statement and complete a personal statement review with the Science and Pre-Health Career and
Internship Coordinator
Take required science courses and maintain required GPA

By March 15th of the Third (or Fourth) Year:
Apply to Complete P3

Students who complete P3 will receive recognition of their accomplishments including a distinctive graduation honor cord and will be provided with a letter of evaluation (commonly referred to as the committee letter) from the Pre-Professional Advisory Committee.
