

**B.F.A. Musical Theatre audition requirements:**

Upload one dance reel to [theatreauditions@flsouthern.edu](mailto:theatreauditions@flsouthern.edu) by **October 11, 2023**

For the in-person audition, prepare two contrasting pieces:

- One song should be a ballad and one song should be an up-tempo
- One song should be written before 1970
- One song should be written after 1970
- Each song should be 60-90 seconds
- Please have accompaniment tracks. A wireless speaker will be provided.

Please bring a headshot, artistic resume, and two letters of recommendation.

**B.F.A. Theatre Performance audition requirements:**

For the in-person audition, prepare two contrasting pieces:

- One dramatic monologue should be classical or contemporary.
- One comedic monologue should be classical or contemporary.
- At least one monologue must be contemporary (written after 1970).
- Monologues must be from a published play or monologue collection. Monologues cannot be from musicals, television shows, or movies.

Please bring a headshot, artistic resume, and two letters of recommendation.

**Dance Audition requirements:**

If you are auditioning for the BFA Dance Performance and Choreography or BA Dance Studies degree programs and would like to be considered for a talent-based scholarship, you must submit a streaming link (YouTube, Vimeo, Google Drive, etc.) of a solo performance in any dance style of your choice to [danceauditions@flsouthern.edu](mailto:danceauditions@flsouthern.edu). This recording may be from a previous formal performance or informal in a dance studio. Individual files that need to be downloaded will not be accepted.
