To whom to talk for guidance with these other complaint/grievance policies & procedures:

Honor Code

If a faculty member imposes a penalty based on an identified Honor Code violation as opposed to forwarding a report to her/his Dean, the student may appeal this faculty instructor's decision to the Honor Code Infraction Review Board (HCIRB). When the HCIRB serves not in its appellate role but conducts a hearing and makes a ruling on a reported Honor Code violation, the student may appeal the HCIRB decision to the Provost or a designated committee.

 - o Appropriate Academic Vice President, Dean or designee, then
 - o Dr. Tracey Tedder, Provost, or a designated committee.
- *Student Accountability
 - May vary. The next-highest supervisor above the person hearing the case hears the appeal.
- *Title IX
 - Rick Gebauer, Director of Student Conduct
- *ADAAA
 - o Dr. Sandy Calvert, Assistant Dean of Student Disability Services
- *FERPA
 - o Lindsay Thibodaux, Registrar
- *<u>Discrimination and Harassment Including Sexual Harassment (Title IX)</u>
 - Concerns by Faculty and Staff (found in Employee Handbook)
 - Seek to resolve with the person who prompted the complaint, then
 - Your immediate supervisor or next-highest supervisor, then

- o Director of Human Resources Katherine Pawlak, then
- Vice President for Finance & Administration Terry Dennis.
- Concerns by Students (found in Employee Handbook)
 - o Seek to resolve with the person who prompted the complaint, then
 - o Director of Student Conduct, Rick Gebauer
